

What Will Happen During the TPF-5(237) Pooled Fund Transition Period (after 9/30)?

Pooled Fund Member Travel or Professional Development	No travel or professional development reimbursement.
OCLC Subscriptions	OCLC invoices received up to 9/30 will be paid. After 9/30, your library will need to pay OCLC directly for any invoices you receive. HS InFocus has contacted individual members affected to let them know the specifics.
Local Earmarked Projects (including Cataloging)	No invoices will be paid after 9/30. <u>Cataloging</u> If the individual states want to continue their cataloging projects, they would have to assume the cost and pay subcontractor invoices. <u>CT Website Project</u> Hosting fee renewed (good through Sept. 2016). CT would have to arrange for maintenance and support after Pooled Fund ends.
Library Connectivity Website	No change in access. All members are registered users and can update and add blog posts and documents at any time. All members 'accounts are set to Author status. Renée has been made an Administrator. Files (documents, reports, logs, brochures, etc.) are available on the Members Only page (Password – TLCDPF) http://libraryconnectivity.org/benefits/for-members/ For functional WordPress issues, contact Steve Wagner svwagner3@wisc.edu (site admin), as we are hosted on the UW-Madison server.
LIBCON-L	Pooled Fund listserv. No change. Hosted by Louisiana Transportation Research Center (LTRC). Sandy Brady is the administrator.
KM Calendar	WordPress site is hosted by LIShost. All WordPress plug-in licenses will be transferred from the subcontractor to MoDOT. Website hosting fee was paid in late August. Limited maintenance and support would have to be provided by members of the subgroup with project oversight (like Laura Wilt, ORDOT) during the transition period. The beta test runs from 9/1-9/30.
TKN Websites	Website hosting fees – No need for action since renewals are due in June 2016. Maintenance and support – ETKN and WTKN would have to edit the websites and update software on their own or arrange separately for support.
Library of Congress (LOC) subscriptions	Renewed in September to cover period 11/15/15-11/14/16 (Cataloger's Desktop) and 11/9/15-11/8/16 (ClassWeb). Access

	would not change.
Springshare LibGuides	Renewed in September to cover period Oct. 2015-Sept. 2018 as approved by the TAC. During the transition period, access will not change and Renée will become the administrator.
